<p>The Adoration of the Magi shows that all people are seeking Jesus, and he comes for the whole world.</p>	<p>Jesus wants us all to know what the kingdom of God is like.</p>
<p>The kingdom of God begins in all those who open their hearts to God's love.</p>	<p>Jesus gives us an invitation to the kingdom of God.</p>
<p>In the parables, Jesus teaches us that we have choices and that sometimes these choices may be difficult.</p>	<p>The miracles Jesus performs are signs of the kingdom of God.</p>
