Key Knowledge

At the Last Supper Jesus showed his love by giving the gift of himself transformed into bread and wine.	Jesus made his apostles priests of his promise when he told them to 'Do this in remembrance of me'
Catholics gather to celebrate Mass where they listen to the words of holy scripture (the Liturgy of the Word) and meet Jesus in Holy Communion (the Liturgy of the Eucharist).	A sacrament is a meeting point where people are blessed by God and become closer to the community of the Church.
The Eucharist is a sacrament in which Jesus offers his life for the salvation of the world.	Jesus is present in Holy Communion to be received by those who believe.
At the Last Supper Jesus instituted the Eucharist.	People give themselves to Jesus when they receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion).
Catholics are called to live Eucharist by following the example of Jesus.	Communion leads Catholics into a deeper relationship with Jesus.
