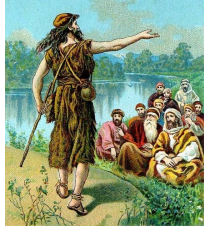

Key Knowledge	
Prophecy means a prediction of what will happen in the future.	For Christians, the prophets awaken an expectation of the coming of the Messiah in people's hearts.
John the Baptist is sent to prepare the way for Jesus.	Elijah is a prophet in the Old Testament, and he calls for the people of Israel to return to God.
In the Advent liturgies, Christians pray for the second coming of Jesus alongside preparing for Christmas.	Advent is a time of preparation for Jesus' incarnation at Christmas and for the second coming as King of the Universe.
The Jesse tree is a representation of the genealogy of Jesus. The Jesse Tree is a way of preparing for Advent by journeying through the stories on Jesus' family tree.	Christians use the Jesse tree during Advent, thinking of the meaning, connecting this to God's plan for salvation.
Pope Pius XI established the Solemnity of Christ the King 1 1925 known as The Feast of Christ the King. It is a reminder that Christ reigns above all earthly rulers.	John the Baptist asks Christians how they will prepare a way for Jesus in their own lives and at the end of all things.
