Module One: Created and Loved by God (Ten Ten)
Everyone is made in the image and likeness of God. It is important to value ourselves and this supports our relationships.

Me, My Body, My Health



Similarities and differences between people can happen as we grow and make choices, that living and working together, teamwork, we create community.

Everyone is uniquely made by a loving God.

Understanding how to stay physically healthy.

To learn about respecting and looking after their bodies as a gift from God, what they wear, eat and physically do.

Identifying body parts and naming genitalia.

Identifying emotions and how they can impact actions. Know what behaviour is wrong, unacceptable, unhealthy and/or risky.

Emotional Well-being

Learn that emotions can change when they grow up. There can be a range and intensity of feelings, that feelings are neither good nor bad, how to manage them.



Personal Relationships

To know the different types of relationships (friends, family, relatives, acquaintances) and what a good friendship is.

To know what kind of physical contact is acceptable and unacceptable – how to respond.

Learning about maintaining and developing good, positive and trusting relationships and to use strategies when relationships go wrong.

Develop a greater awareness of bullying, including cyber-bullying and how to respond to this.

What to do in an emergency and knowing how to use first aid.

How to use technology safely.

With increasing independence brings increased responsibility to keep themselves and others safe.
